## Dress Code 2021-2022

---

Attire that disrupts the educational process, threatens the learning environment, endangers the health and safety of students or any others will not be tolerated.

### General Appearance

- Face covering mask are optional. Face coverings may not contain offensive language or symbols.
- Students must wear a LGMS school t-shirt.
  - **6th grade** will be required to wear the Gray Polo or LGMS T-shirt.
  - **7th grade** will be required to wear the Royal Blue Polo or LGMS T-shirt.
  - **8th grade** will be required to wear either the Navy Blue Polo or LGMS T-shirt

\*Polo shirts should be collared with 2-3 buttons
- Students shall wear clothing of appropriate size as determined by the principal or designee.
- **Students** will wear Khaki-Tan or Black pants or shorts made of cotton and/or twill. (no denim material)
- **Students** will wear Khaki-Tan or Black pants (no leggings), skirts, skorts or shorts made of cotton and/or twill. (no denim material)
- SHORTS, SKIRTS, SKORTS, and PANTS: must be hemmed (No fraying material).
- No sweat pants or athletic shorts will be allowed outside of PE.
- Shorts and skirts must be no shorter than  **fingertip length**  with hands at side.
- Pants/shorts cannot have any holes, frays or writing on them. They must be worn around the waist with a belt.
- Hats are not to be worn on campus.
- Blankets, bedroom slippers, and/or pajamas are not allowed.
- Jackets/Outer Garments: button up, zip front, or partial zips. **CAN NOT HAVE A HOOD. Students wearing a jacket with a hood will have them collected and returned at the end of the day.** No trench coats.
- Shoes: only closed toe shoes allowed (no Crocs, slides, sandals or open toe shoes).
- Student ID's: must be worn on lanyard around the neck or on a clip worn on upper torso to be visible always.

Students in violation of the dress code will not be allowed to attend classes or participate in after school activities until they meet the policies set forth by Lake Gibson Middle School.

### LGMS Dress Down Days

Students MUST abide by all dress code regulations set forth in the Polk County Public Schools Code of Conduct.

#### What NOT to wear:

- No leggings/compression shorts
- No jeans with holes, tears, or frays
- No tank tops/sleeveless shirts or shirts with "cut outs"
- No hoodies
- No overalls
- No hats
- No open toe shoes, slides, CROCS
- No sweatpants

#### What you MAY wear:

- Athletic shorts of appropriate length
- Jeans with NO holes, tears, or frays
